- **Fewer authorized partners:** Broadcom's new invitation-only model limits VMware partnerships to a select few, including Flexential
- **Exit deadlines:** Non-renewing partners must cease new business by October 31, 2025
- **Continuity risks:** Customers must confirm their provider can offer uninterrupted licensing and support
- **Strategic shift:** Broadcom now prioritizes hyperscale private cloud platforms via elite partners
